
6.3-E- Volume of a Sphere

$$V_{\text{sphere}} = 2 V_{\text{cone}}$$

$$= 2\left(\frac{\pi r^2 \cdot h}{3}\right)$$

$$= 2\left(\frac{\pi r^2 \cdot 2r}{3}\right)$$

$$= \frac{4\pi r^3}{3}$$



$$V_{\text{sphere}} = \frac{4\pi r^3}{3}$$

$$V_{\text{sphere}} = \frac{4\pi r^3}{3}$$

Ex 2: Find the volume of the Earth in km³




r = 6378 km
